Your Unique ID is your employee ID; for your spouse/partner this is your employee ID + an 'S' at the end; for dependent children, this is your employee ID + a 'C1' for the first child, 'C2' for the second child, etc. added to the end

For example, if you are the employee, your Unique ID will be ABC999, your spouse/partner's Unique ID will be ABC999S and your dependent child will be ABC999C1
